

Updated March 26, 2021: Cost of a U-Haul Between Cities (columns = from; rows = to)



Example: The cost to rent a U-Haul from Philadelphia to Tampa is \$4,121. The cost to rent a U-Haul back from Tampa to Philadelphia is \$864. $\$4121 / \$864 = 4.77$

Example: The cost to rent a U-Haul from Philadelphia to Tampa is \$2,826. The cost to rent a U-Haul back from Tampa to Philadelphia is \$785. $\$2826 / \$785 = 3.60$

Example: The cost to rent a U-Haul from Philadelphia to Tampa is \$2,826. The cost to rent a U-Haul back from Tampa to Philadelphia is \$636. $\$2826 / 636 = 4.44$
